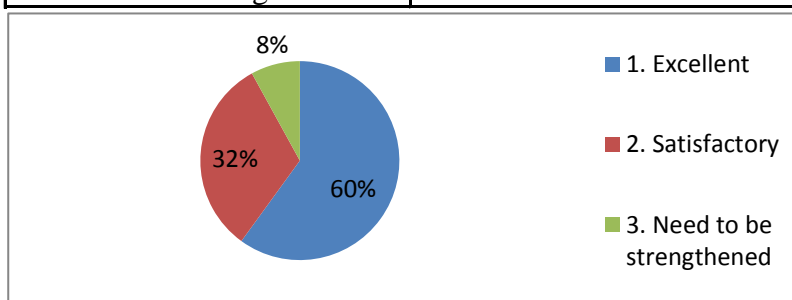

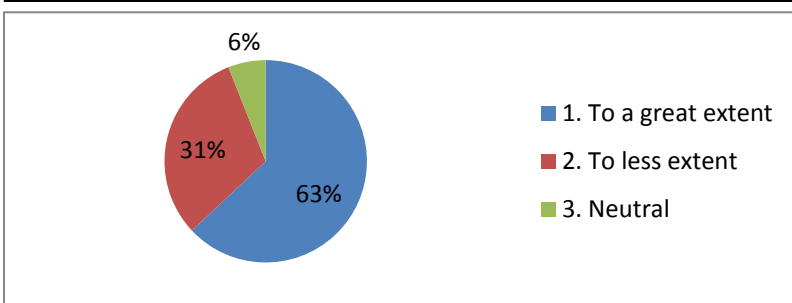

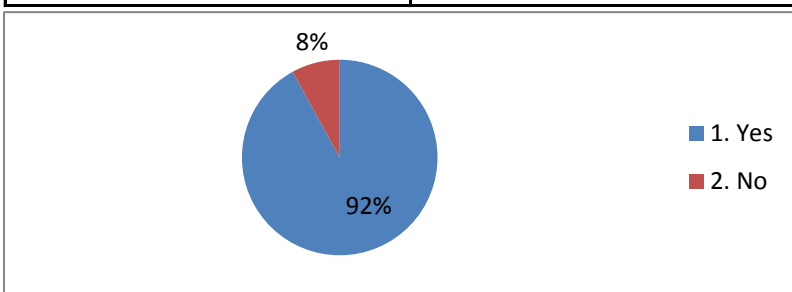
2. Were the inputs provided by the Institution helpful in your professional growth?

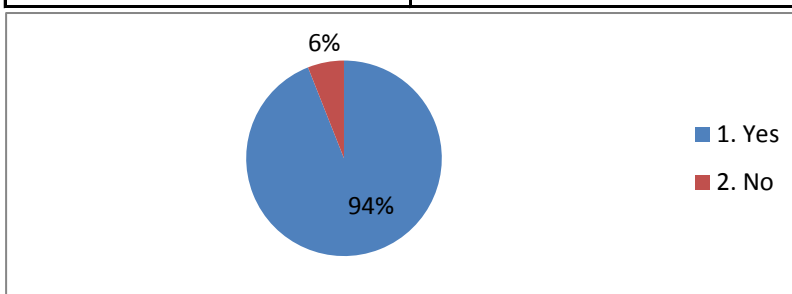

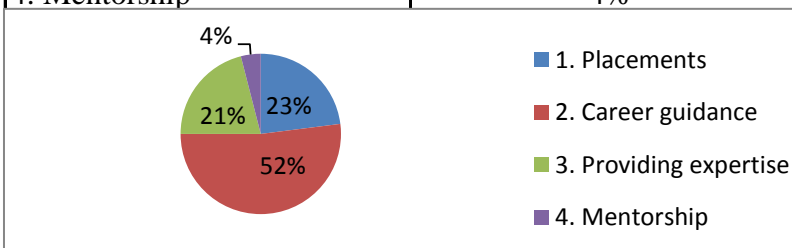

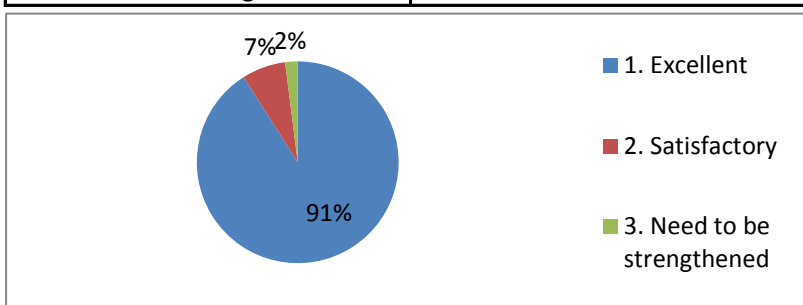

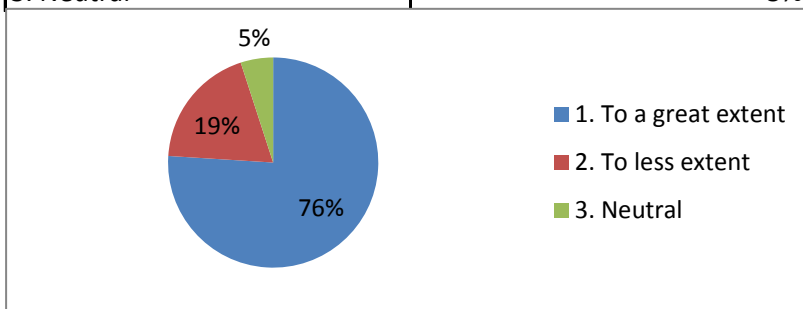

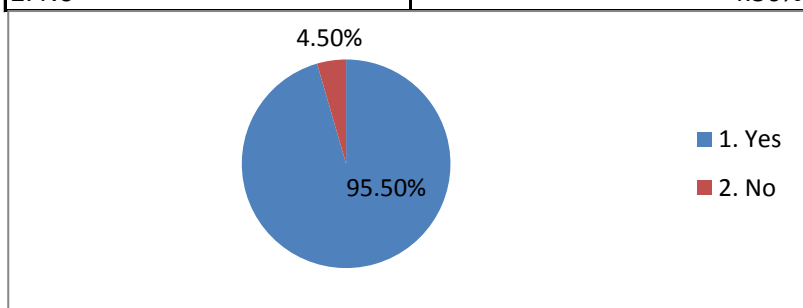

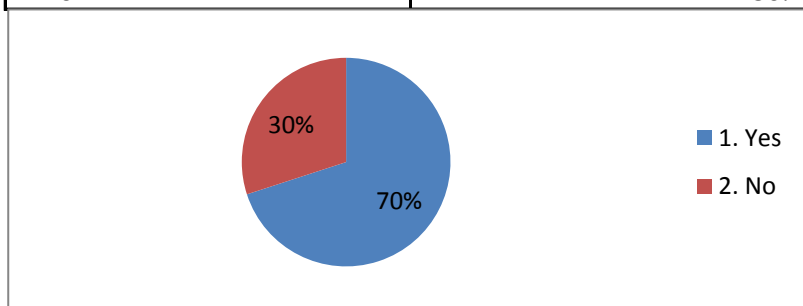

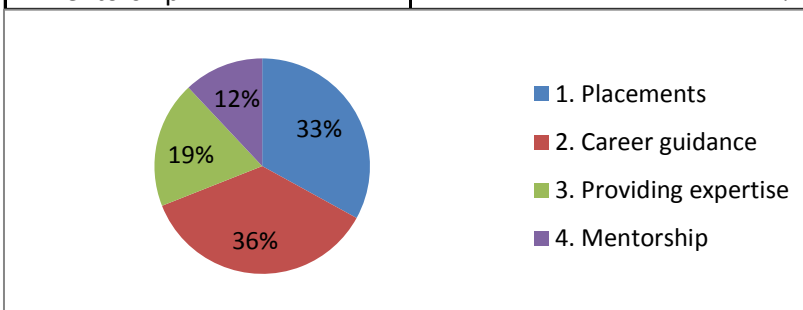

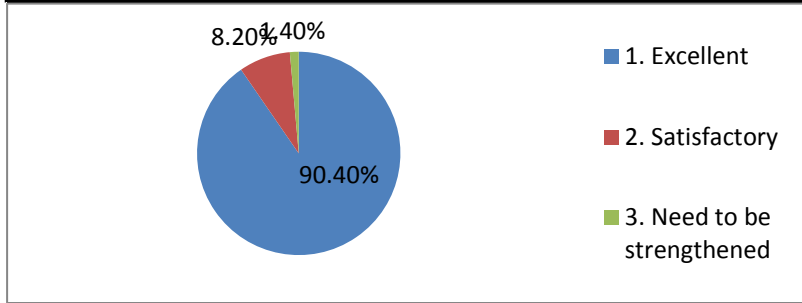

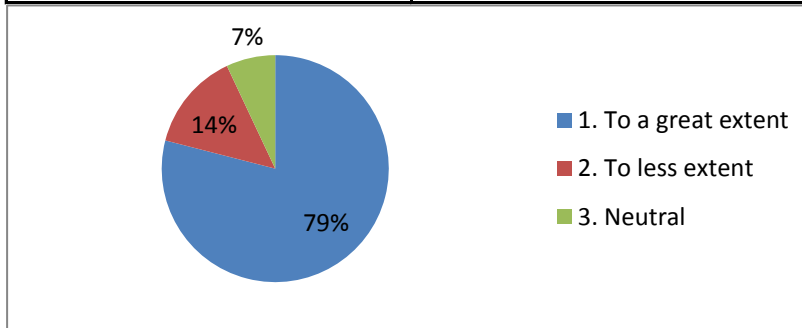

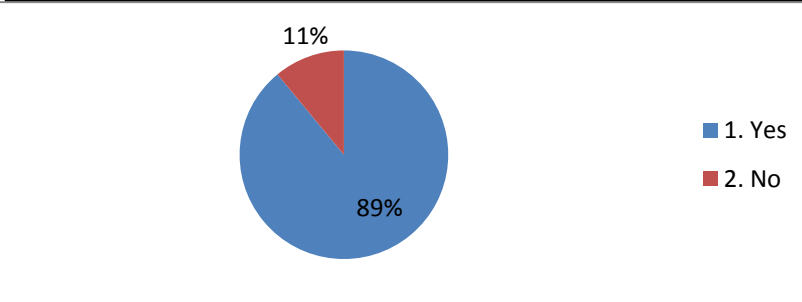
4. Were the inputs provided by the Institution helpful in your professional growth?

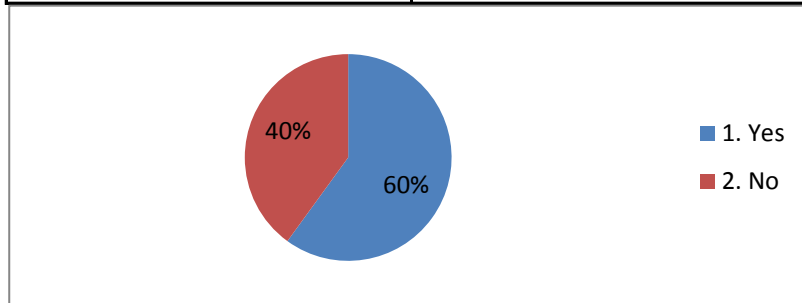

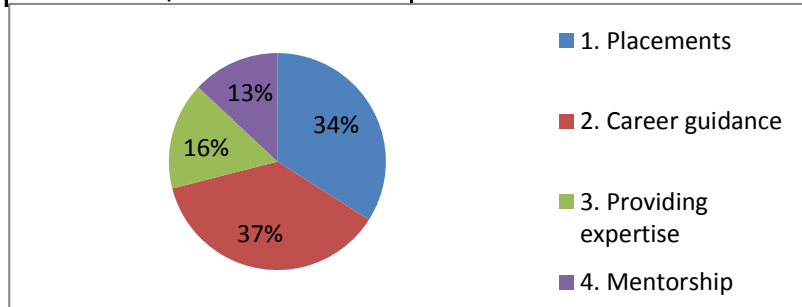

They said extra curricular activities like NCC,NSS have helped them to grow as responsible and discipline individuals and helped them in building confidence to

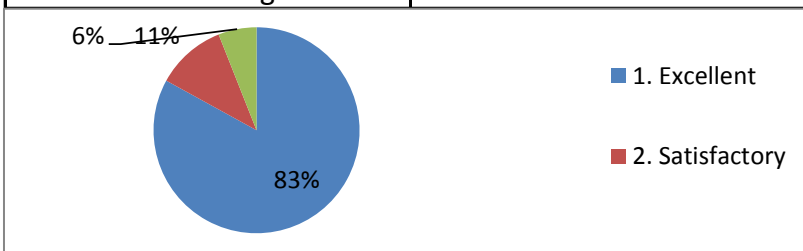
They thanked the lecturers for their guidance,support and for their valuable suggestions in professional and personal front.

They described faculty as informative, committed, dedicated and dynamic.

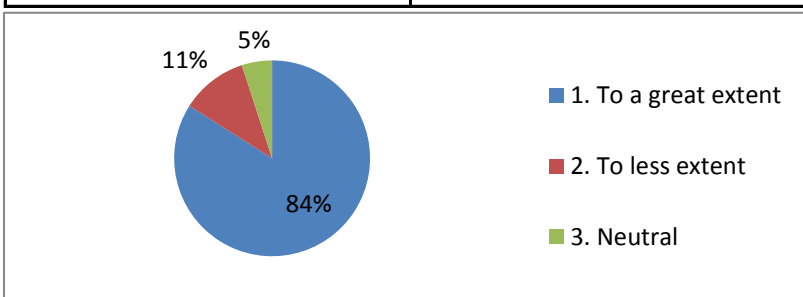

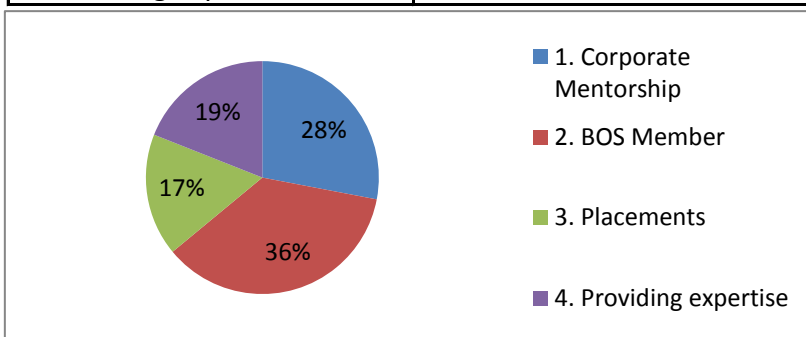

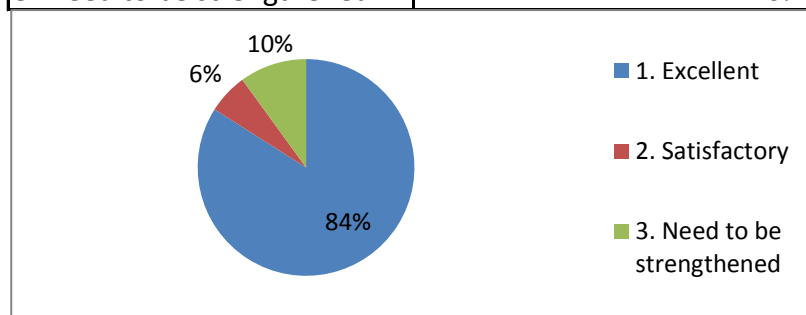
Alumni Feedback Analysis 2016-17

Thanked the lecturers for their guidance, support and for their valuable suggestions both in professional and personal front.

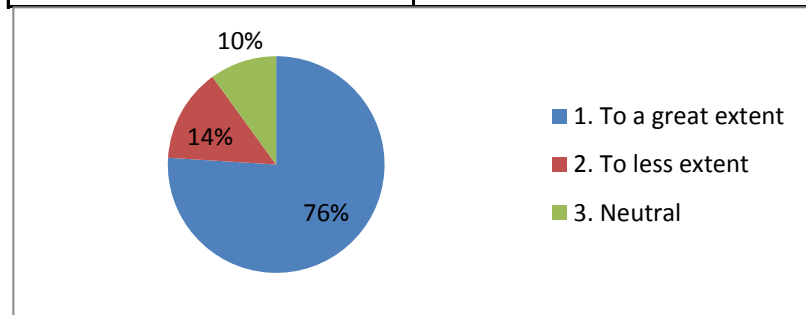

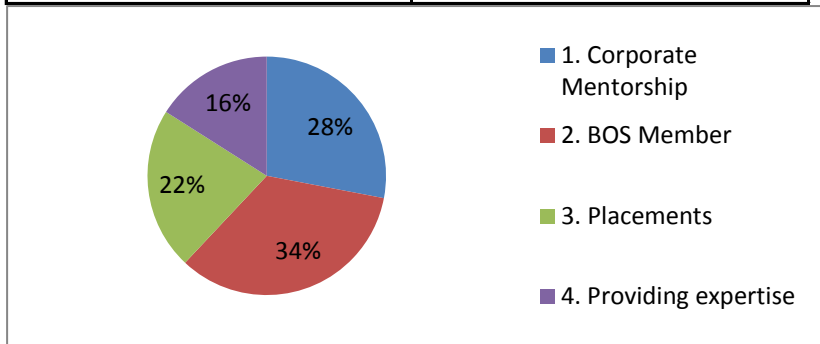
