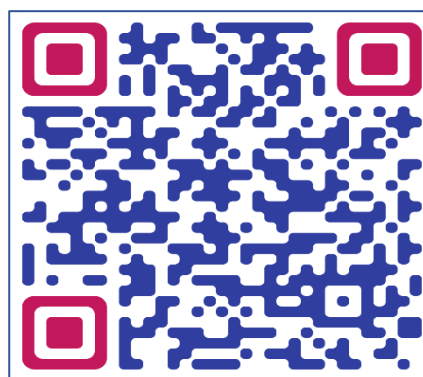
### Tasks and Responsibilities

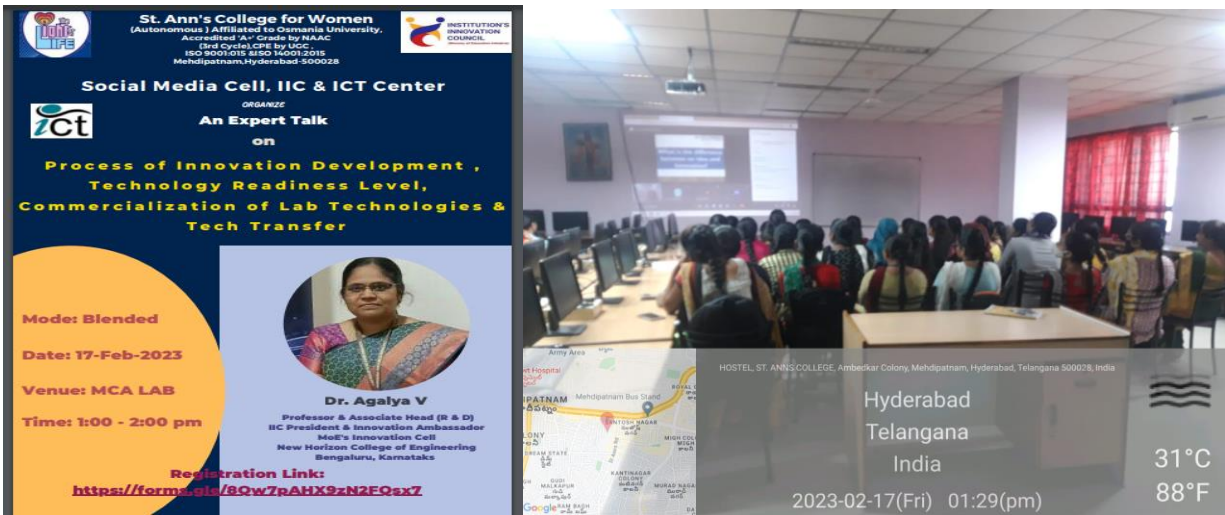



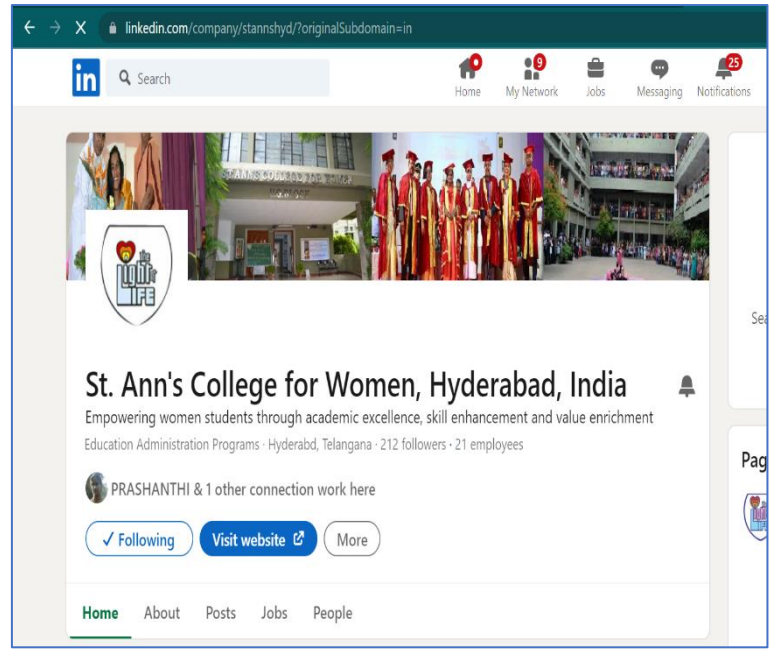
