1. The Department of English and the Department of Library and Information Science organised a reading and writing workshop in collaboration with HydRAW which was held in St. Joseph's auditorium on 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2019. The workshop started with a prayer by the students. The event commenced with the opening words of Ms. Sunita David, HOD of the Department of English followed by the introduction of the guest speakers –Mr. Mahboob Hussain, Ms. Lavanya Nukavarapu, Mr. Arun Kumar and Mr. Swapnil Saurav. It then proceeded to the first guest speaker Mr. Mahboob Hussain, giving a brief introduction about HydRAW and its achievements and an overview of the writing process. The next speaker Ms. Lavanya Nukavarapu spoke about her research process for her book *The Captive*.

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A presentation and video was shown to the audience of how she conducted her research, the process and the struggle during her research. Methods and techniques were shared with students on how to find the actual information for their writing. Mr. Arun Kumar spoke about Ruskin Bond. The intricacies of Ruskin Bond story writing, the common pattern of plot and nature of his writings were discussed along with presenting different videos to the students. The last session was the Literary Quiz for students organized by Mr. Swapnil Saurav. Six teams, each comprising of two students took part. There were various rounds - literature. General knowledge, current affairs etc. Quotes from different books were to be identified, quick questions were asked concerning various books and authors, clips of trailers were to be identified. The quiz was well received by the audience with their enthusiastic participation. Books and chocolates were given as prizes for the three winning teams. The event ended with the vote of thanks by Ms. Sunita David, HOD of the Department of English.

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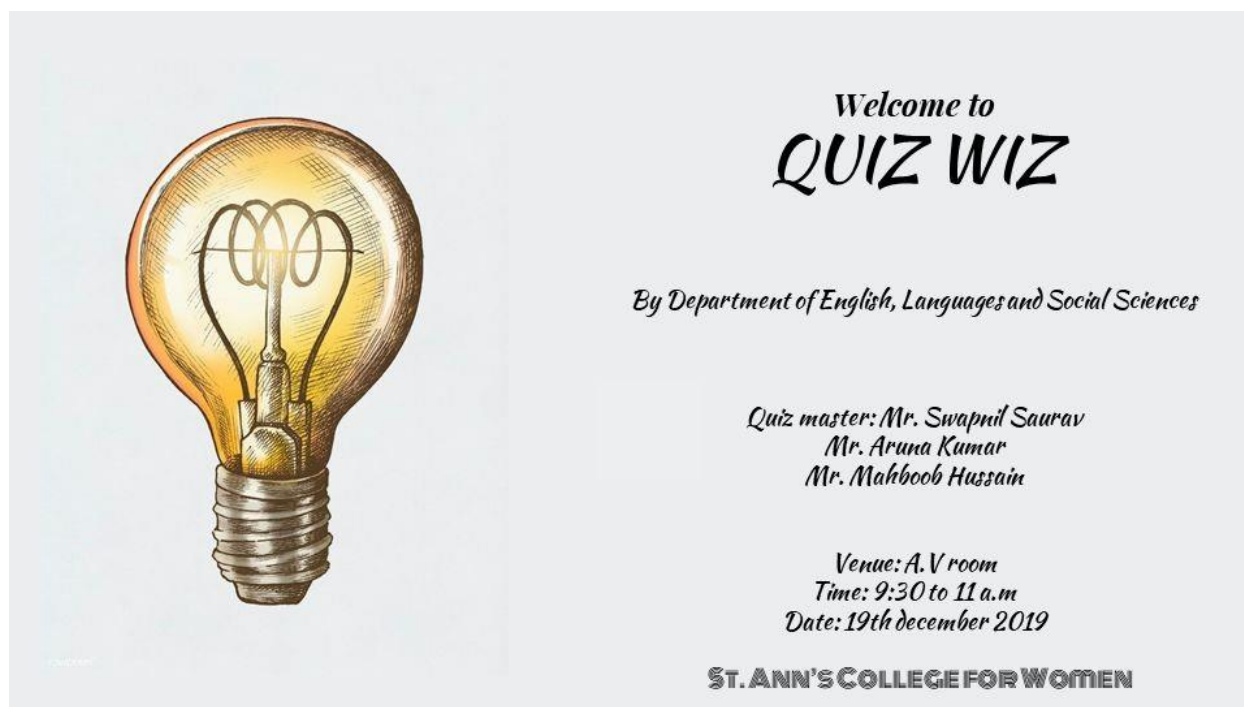
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### 3. Quiz Wiz -Annofesta 2019

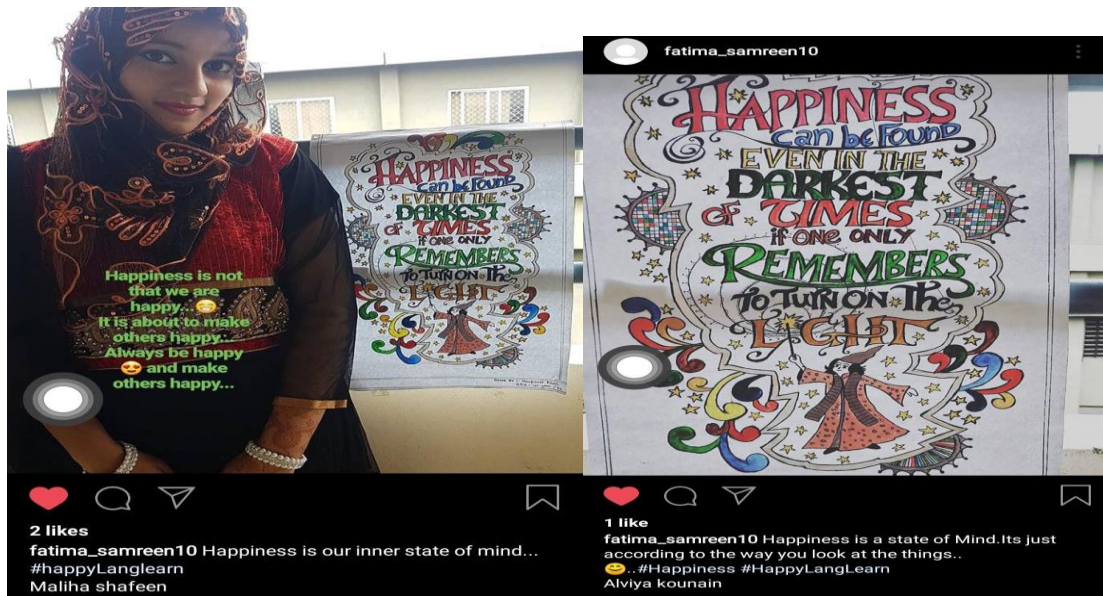
## 4. #HappyLangLearn Report
