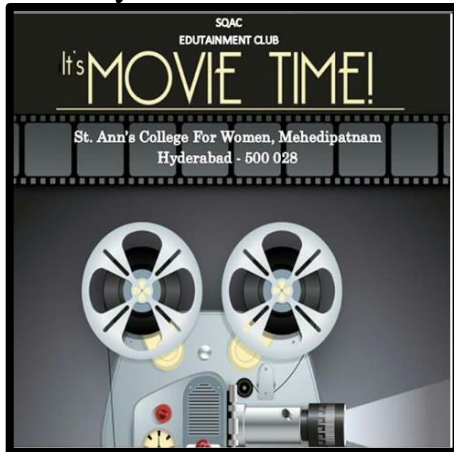
22. Republic Day:
