




# 2. SQAC ORIENTATION

## 4. 'WOULD YOU RATHER'GAME




#### 7. INVESTITURE CEREMONY

## 8. WORLD AIDS DAY



## 13. ANTI RAGGING PROGRAMME








## 14. FIVE WAVES OF FEMINISM


#### 15.TIMES OF INDIA






# **The Tribute Online Treasure Hunt**

On 19th June, 2021, SQAC organized the Hunt for lecturers. On 20th June,


