<u>1.</u> WORLD AIDS DAY-

On 1st December 2022, SQAC in collaboration with the Microbiology Department, raised awareness among college staff and students. 6. WORLD DIABETES DAY




23. MY THRIFT PLATE


26. KINDNESS CHALLENGE




- 1. Channelizing Youth Power for Nation Building.


46. AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV QUIZ COMPETITION
