15. KARRA SAMU CERTIFICATION CEREMONY

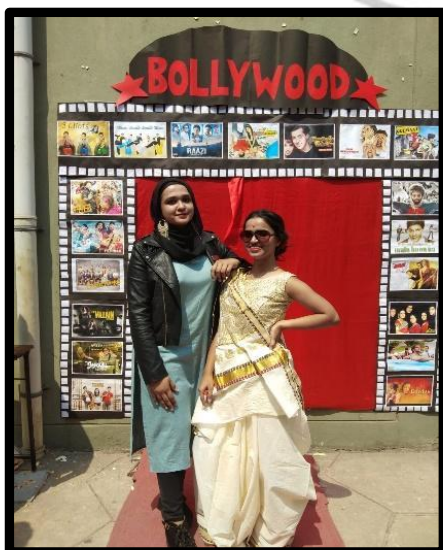

23. INTER COLLEGE COLLAGE COMPETITION

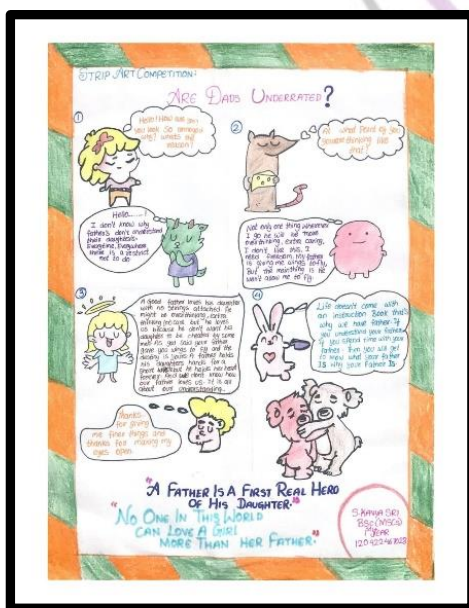
(Nutrition Department in collaboration with SQAC)

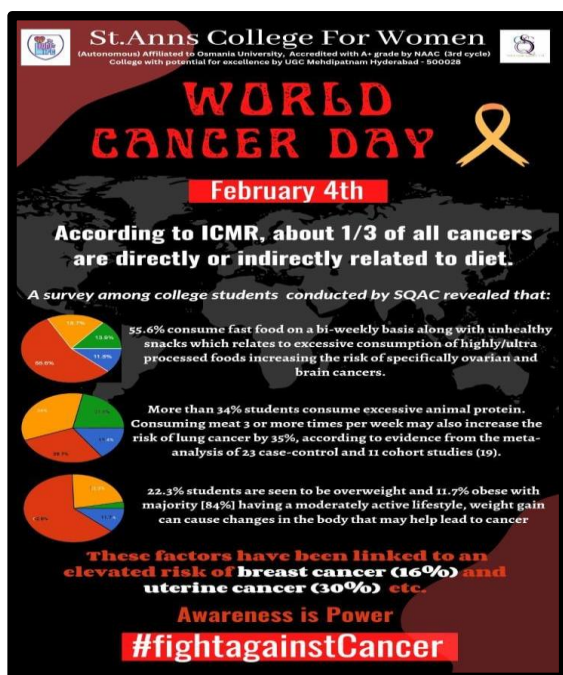
49. INTERNATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS DAY

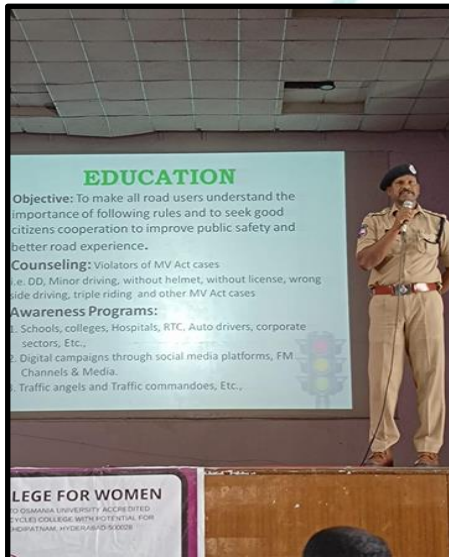


57. TRAFFIC AWARENESS PROGRAMME

On 30th January, 2023, SQAC organized a Traffic Awareness Programme in the St.

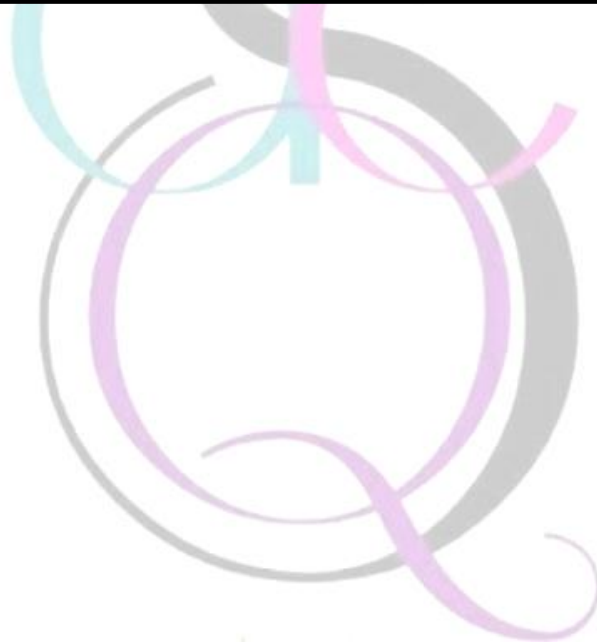
