Republic day and its importance in The Indian history and for the citizens of India.

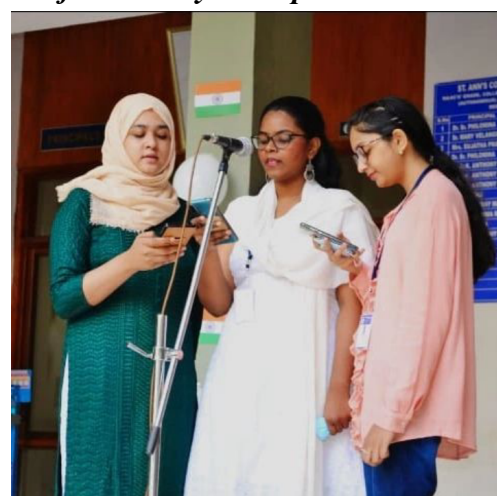
