Facilitating the creation of a learner-centric environment conducive for quality education and faculty maturation to adopt the required knowledge and technology for participatory teaching and learning process. IQAC facilitates, coordinates, organises, evaluates all events, arranges for feedback, works towards the development and maintenance of institutional database through ERP and MIS for the purpose of maintaining /enhancing the institutional quality and dissemination of information on the various quality parameters of higher education.

The Institution with Autonomy status was initiated in 2015, with effective quality management system standards ISO 9001:2015 and ISO 14001:2015 certifications in 2021, enabled us to create an educational system that best carries out the mission and goals. Quality, as a living metric, emphasizes the need-based approach to meet the students' dynamic challenges. The institution offers 34 programs in total, including 26 undergraduate programs leading to Bachelor degrees; 7 courses in Bachelor of Arts (B.A.), 12 courses in Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.), 6 courses in Bachelor of Commerce and B.Com, 1 -Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA), and 8 post-graduate programs leading to the degrees of Master of Business Administration(MBA), Master of Computer Application (MCA), Master of Commerce(M.Com.), Master of Science(M.Sc.) in Chemistry, Clinical Nutrition& Dietetics, P.G. Diploma in Nutrition & Dietetics, P.G. Diploma in Data Analytics and P.G.Diploma in Counselling Psychology.UG& PG programs adhere to a semester pattern.

The institution provides choice-based based credit courses to the student fraternity to enhance knowledge in specific areas and provides additional skills required for the corporate world. The array of Skill Oriented Courses (SOC) & Co-Curricular Activities (CCA) offered for First-year students, Career Oriented Courses (COC)- (some courses are UGC recognized) offered for second-year students, and Interdisciplinary Courses (IDC) for third-year students. The curriculum design of choice-based credit courses enhances the learning skills of students confined to specific subjects designed by



faculties to meet the needs of corporate, appreciable stakeholders in the moulding personality of students for futuristic endeavors.

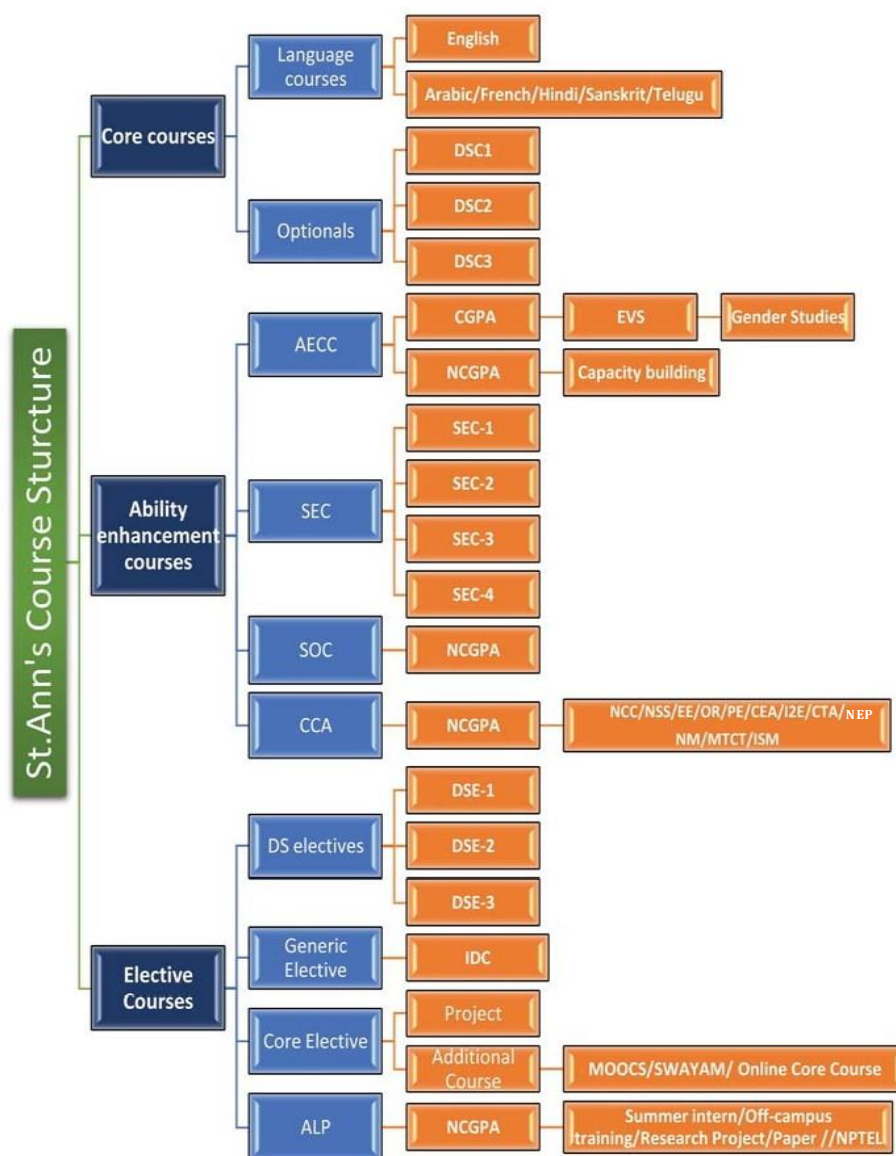

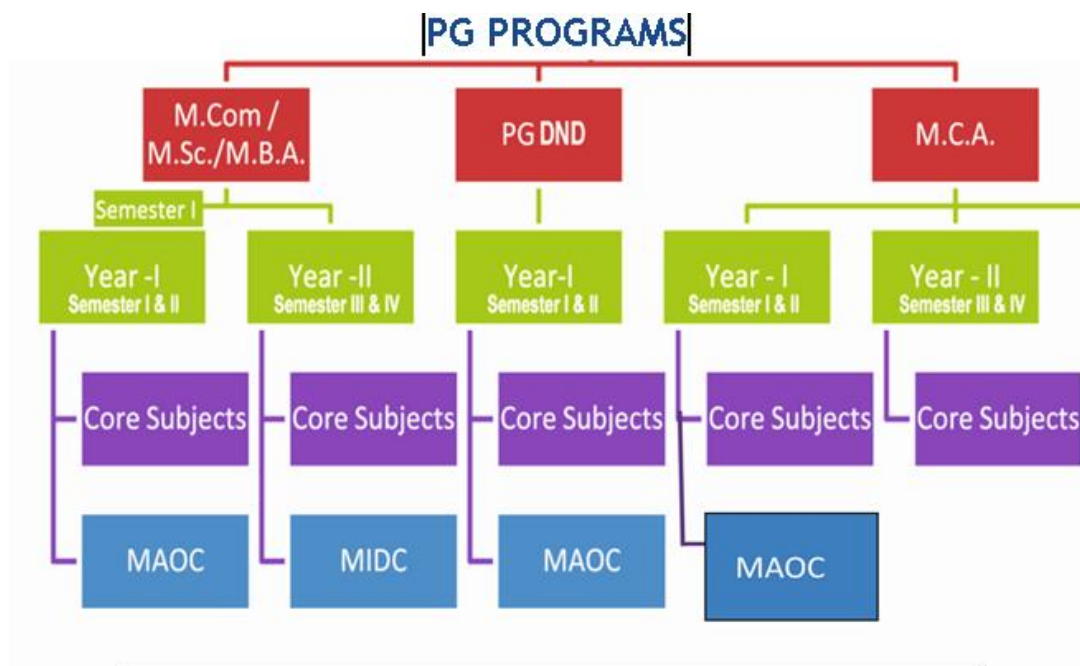

### **Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) Offered 2022-23**

The Institution introduced SEC courses as per **UGC norms this Academic year (2022-23)** to empower students to unlock their full potential. These courses bridge the gap between academic learning and practical application which enables students to apply knowledge in real life situations.

These courses are tailored to specific career paths which are aligned to industry relevance enhancing their employability upon graduation.





The structure of SEC curriculum is offered to Second-year students in both semesters (Semester III and Semester IV). Four courses are offered - 2 are UGC-specified, and 2 are department-specified. Each semester includes one UGC-specified course as well as one department-specified course. A student earns two credits for each course, for a total of eight credits when all four courses are completed. Courses are offered in partnership with a variety of industries and organizations. The expertise of resource individuals and the guidance of in-house professors will enhance the learning experience of students.

## 2. Advance Learner Program (ALP)

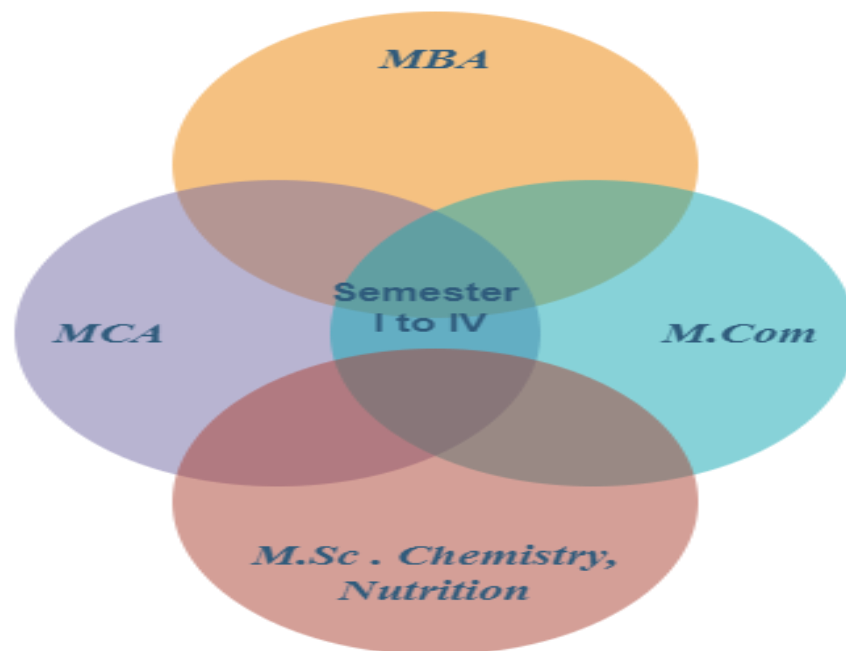

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
