





SESSION ON SIGNIFICANCE OF ARABIC LANGUAGE


- The session was started by explaining the purpose and importance of Amrozia Club in the College. The meaning of the club name "Amrozia" i.e "Women of Today".


BAIT BAAZI



- The models were evaluated on their accuracy, complexity, and overall design and displayed to motivate other students.


















