The education and exposure that the students gain during two years of their course renders them confident to join the world of business and face the challenges of the corporate environment.

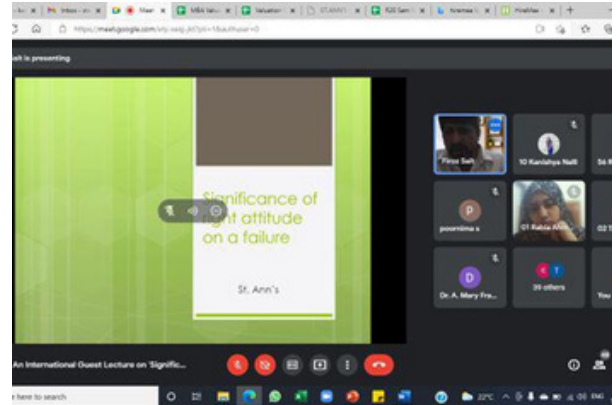
