2023 - 2024

- The choices provided for various courses are excellent as per 52.5% students, good for 39% and can be improved according to 8.5% students.
- According to the feedback, 53.2% students opined that the course content is excellent, 38.4% felt it is good, but 8.4% students feel it needs to be improved.
- The allotment of credit is excellent as per 51.7% students, good as per 38.7%, where as needs to be improved for 9.6%.
- 89.1% students feel the relevance of curriculum is excellent and very good and it reaches the local, national and global needs, where as 10.9% felt curriculum needs to be improved.
- Technology integration is crucial and it is excellent as per 45.3% students, 32.2% students felt it is good and helpful whereas, 22.5% felt it needs improvement.
- The unitization of syllabus is excellent for 21.8% students, very good for 67% students and needs improvement for 11.2% students.
- The industrial exposure in curriculum is excellent and very good as per 43.3% respondents, good for 24% students and needs to be improved as per 22.5% students.



Alumni Feedback on Curriculum

Analysis 2023-24

1. The curriculum is well designed and promotes enriched learning experience and it is excellent as per 86.8% respondents and 10.4 % of the alumni felt it was very good, and 2.8% felt it needs to be improved.

2. The seminars, workshops, special training conducted by the institution is excellent as per 81.1% alumni, other 12.3 feel it is very good and bridges the industry-academia

gap, and 6.6% feel it needs to be improved.

3. The focus on employability, entrepreneurship and skill development was excellent as per the opinion of 77.4% alumni and it was very good and satisfactory for 17.9% alumni, where as 2.8% alumni feel it needs improvement and other 1.9% feel the curriculum is poor.

4. The value-added courses are very helpful and excellent, very useful for holistic development as per the response of 83% alumni and 14.2% felt it was very good and satisfactory where as 0.9% feel it needs improvement and 1.9% felt it is poor and

needs a change in value added courses.

5. 81.1% alumni felt curriculum is designed helped to raise professionals and entrepreneurs and it is excellent, 14.2 respondents felt it was very good, other 2.8% feel it is average and 1.9% felt it is to be improved.

The feedback analysis shows roughly 2% of the respondents expressed the need for improvement towards campus training for placement entrepreneur development.

- As per the responses received 68% respondents felt the course relevance towards employability and entrepreneurship is excellent and other 25% respondents felt the relevance of course is very good ,7% responders felt it is average.
- 71% parents felt course focus on skill development was excellent and 24% parents observed it is very good, and the remaining 5% parents felt the course need to be improved.

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

Report on Employer's Feedback on Curriculum 2023-24

The purpose of this report is to analyze the feedback received from various companies regarding the relevance and up-to-datedness of the curriculum at St. Ann's College. The feedback aims to assess how well the curriculum prepares students for their chosen careers by providing them with a broad understanding of knowledge. Dell Technologies, Verizon, ADP, Invesco, The Dollar Business, Sagility, Synchrony, and other companies provided curriculum feedback in 2023-24. The feedback provided by employers regarding our college's overall curriculum has been instructive. According to the report, most employers concur that the curriculum focuses on skills rather than updated content. Below is a breakdown of the feedback received.



1. Relevance and Career Knowledge Development: In the first statement, respondents were asked to assess the curriculum's relevance and the students' career knowledge

- development. According to the report, all companies agreed that the curriculum at St. Ann's College aids students in gaining knowledge about their chosen professions.
- 2. Emphasis on Discipline-specific Knowledge and Modern Tools: This statement was requested to determine whether the curriculum emphasizes applying discipline-specific knowledge, techniques, skills, and modern tools. The report revealed that most of the companies rated excellent and very good. This implies that the curriculum emphasizes the need to improve discipline-appropriate knowledge, techniques, skills, and modern tools.
- 3. Equipping Students with Personal, Social, and Employability Skills: This statement was requested to assess the curriculum's ability to equip students with the personal, social, and employability skills necessary to pursue successful careers. The report indicates that few of the companies were rated outstanding, while more companies were rated excellent. This indicates that the curriculum does an excellent job of equipping students with the personal, social, and employability skills they need to pursue successful careers.
- 4. **Development of Communication and Soft Skills:** This question was posed to determine how much the curriculum helps students develop communication and soft skills. The report explains that all the companies agreed that the curriculum shapes students' communication and social skills development. This indicates that the curriculum effectively shapes students' communication and emotional skills.
- 5. Preparation for Managerial and Leadership Roles: This statement was intended to assess how curricular practices such as internships, student exchange programs, and field trips equip students with managerial and leadership skills. The report indicates that some companies evaluated it as excellent, while others rated it very good. This indicates that St. companies curricular practices are superior in preparing students to acquire managerial and leadership skills.
- 6. Ability to Quickly Acquire Industrial Practices and Adapt: This question was asked to determine whether or not students have the ability to quickly acquire industrial practices and adapt to the stream. The report explains that the majority of companies were rated excellent, some were rated very good, and a small number were rated good and average. This indicates that the curriculum must develop students' ability to quickly acquire industrial practices and adapt to the stream.
- 7. **Training in Teamwork and Initiative:** This question was asked to determine whether or not students have the ability to acquire industrial practices and adapt to the stream quickly. The report explains that the majority of companies were rated excellent, some were rated very good, and a small number were rated good and average. This indicates that the

Feedback Analysis

2023-24

- 1. The adequacy of the curriculum in addressing Local/Regional/National needs is rated as excellent by 65% of the faculty.
- 2. A significant majority, 71%, express satisfaction with the academic flexibility provided by the wide range of courses offered under CBCS.
- 3. 76% of faculty members find the plan of curriculum structure, particularly in terms of credit allocation and syllabus utilization, to be excellent, while the remaining 24% rate it
- 4. Integration of courses for skill and personality development is deemed excellent by about 71% of the faculty.
- 5. Similarly, 71% of faculty members commend the curriculum enrichment efforts, including the integration of value-added add-on courses and academic enrichment opportunities, as excellent.
