"Geopolitics" G20 Summit Highlights

After 183 meetings, the G20 summit has produced some groundbreaking outcomes that will shape our world. Here are the top takeaways you need to know:

- Increased Credit Access for Developing Nations:
 Due to the pandemic and rising oil prices, many countries faced increased borrowing, leading to rising interest and debt burdens. India pushed for debt restructuring under the G20 Common Framework, including time-bound country-specific restructuring and coordinated actions by debtors, creditors, and multilateral institutions like the IMF.
- Crypto Regulation: India advocated for a comprehensive and global approach to crypto regulation. A Presidency Note outlined the need to cater to the needs of developing nations, addressing macro-risks, a roadmap for future policy inclusions, and industry-specific responses. If adopted, it would be India's significant contribution to the G20.
- Action towards Climate Change: G20 nations reaffirmed their commitment to the Paris Agreement, aiming to limit global temperature increases to 1.5°C, safeguard food production, and provide financing for climate-related initiatives.
- **Gender Equality**: Headed by 20 women, the W20 focused on empowering women in leadership roles, bridging the gender gap, entrepreneurship, education, and climate resistance action.

• Sector-Specific Schemes: Robust projects were launched, including the Financial Intermediary Fund to combat pandemics, Debt Service Suspension Initiative to support low-income nations during pandemics, and the G20 Sustainable Roadmap to foster nature-related economic activities. Talks were held in Udaipur and Bengaluru to address tech transformation, green growth, global macro stability, financial inclusion, and future city development. Projects like Disaster Risk Education and the Startup-20 Engagement Group were initiated.




Delhi Declaration: The 83-point Delhi Declaration laid out key objectives, such as reforming debt vulnerability, enhancing cross-border payments, and implementing policies to counter money laundering through a 2-pillared global tax package. Notably, the African Union was included as a part of the G20, and the declaration was passed unanimously with 100% support.

Here's how 64-year-old Ramesh Gera grows saffron in closed rooms and earns in lakhs

An opportunity to visit South Korea for work purposes resulted in establishing his own farming business. Ramesh Gera is a 64-year-old retired engineer from Noida. In the year 2002, he went to South Korea on a business trip and returned with immense knowledge of advanced farming techniques.

During his 6-month stay, he learned about hydroponic farming, microgreens and indoor saffron cultivation. After getting retired from his work in 2017, he devoted all his time to farming and today he cultivates saffron in 100 square feet of land in Noida.

Who is Ramesh Gera?

Ramesh Gera is a resident of Hisar, Haryana. He did electrical engineering in 1980. He spent his working life quite peacefully. In 2017, his wife passed away due to serious health issues. His son lives in Australia and his daughter works in Mumbai. Post his retirement, Ramesh had plenty of free time on his hands; he experimented with advanced farming and utilized the knowledge he had gained decades ago.

In his research, he found that only Kashmir has a suitable weather for the growth of saffron. A large amount of saffron is imported from Iran, one of the largest producers of saffron. Ramesh decided to experiment growing saffron in a room in Noida.

Blooming of flowers

Ramesh shares that he creates an artificial favorable climate for growing saffron in closed rooms; he calls these rooms greenhouses. He installs necessary equipment to produce the effect. Saffron seeds are bought from Kashmir and are cultivated in the greenhouses. It takes almost 3 months for the seeds to transform into flowers.

Saffron is extracted from the flowers in the fourth month of the growth.

Cost of indoor saffron cultivation

Ramesh Gera spent Rs 4 lakh in the construction of the green house; Rs 2 lakh were spent in obtaining saffron seeds from Kashmir. Adding up, a sum of Rs 6 lakh was invested in saffron farming.

After gaining profit from the sales, Ramesh has started giving training to people to learn the methods of indoor cultivation of saffron. Ramesh shares that only one time investment is required in the beginning, apart from that one only needs to pay the electricity bills. His electricity bills cost around Rs 4500 a month and the labour costs are rounded up to Rs 8 thousand in a year.



Quality of saffron

The saffron produced in the greenhouses can compete with the quality of Kashmir's saffron brand Mogra. Apart from saffron, Ramesh Gera also cultivates exotic vegetables and flowers by using hydroponic farming techniques. He also grows 50 types of microgreens in his greenhouses. Presently, he sells one kilogram of saffron at Rs 2.40 lakh in the wholesale market whereas the price increases up to Rs 3.50 lakh per kg in the retail market.

APG Shipyard Bank Scam

ABG Shipyard Ltd is a part of the ABG Group of companies with diversified business interests. Established in 1985, it is headquartered in Mumbai. It has shipbuilding operations in Surat and Dahej in Gujarat. Following its acquisition of Western India Shipyard Limited in October 2010, it operates a ship repair unit in Goa which is the largest ship maintenance facility in India.

ABG became one of the largest private ship building companies in India with a capacity to manufacture vessels up to 20 tonnes in weight. In January 2019, a forensic audit by E&Y revealed that ABG had defrauded a 28-member consortium of bankers to the tune of Rs 22000 crores. Following this in November 2019, State bank of India petitioned CBI to conduct an investigation. CBI asked the bank to investigate at their level to check for involvement of bank insiders which was ruled out subsequently. Post this in September 2020 SBI filed a fresh complaint seeking investigation in to the role of public servants and other persons in the fraud. In February 2022, a look out circular was issued against the ABG former Chairman Rishi Agarwal and others in the case.

Since 1985, the ABG shipyard, a firm connected to the ABG group, has been engaged in the shipbuilding and repair industry. Rishi Kamlesh Agarwal served as the organization's previous chairman and managing director, and it operates two shipyards in Gujarat.

The ABG Shipyard Scam, the largest banking fraud in India of Rs 22,848 crores, involves the company. The company obtained loans from a group of 28 banks during a five-year period, from 2012 to 2017, but did not use the funds for the intended purpose. Even during the 2008 worldwide deflation brought on by the fiscal crisis, which decreased demand for and the price of goods as well as cargo, the corporation took out loans. The shipyard industry was negatively impacted by this. The State Bank of India then made the decision in 2014 to restructure the loans issued to the company under the Corporate Debt Restructuring programme. Due to the company's financial difficulties brought on by the global fiscal crisis, it was deemed a non-performing asset since it was unable to make instalment payments.



As a result, SBI discovered the fraud in January 2019 and reported it. According to an Ernst and Young audit, there was evidence of fraud by the company between 2012 and 2017. Loan funds were misappropriated and diverted to be invested through foreign subsidiaries or shell companies, resulting in a criminal breach of trust with the intent to make money illegally off the loan funds. After requesting explanations from the SBI complaint that was filed in 2021, the CBI filed a FIR in February 2022.

ENTREPRENUER SERIES

VINEETA SINGH FOUNDER- SUGAR COSMETICS

Vineeta Singh is an Indian entrepreneur and CEO and cofounder of Sugar Cosmetics. In 2007, Singh founded her first start-up Quetzal. However, the idea of providing background verification checks to recruiters failed to succeed. She started her second start-up Fab-Bag in 2012, a subscription platform that provided monthly deliveries of beauty products. Her third start-up, Sugar Cosmetics, Singh founded together with her husband in 2015. The company sells cosmetics and personal care products geared towards the Indian market. After closing a \$50 million deal with private equity firm L Catterton, Singh characterized the company's products as catering to the preferences of women with diverse skin tones.

Singh appeared on the hard copy cover pages of business magazines, such as Forbes India, Business Today, and Businessworld. To Business Today, she revealed that funding was once only granted under the condition that her husband joined the company full-time, which she viewed as gender discrimination.

Singh received a lot of awards for her start-up sugar cosmetics, and few of them are,Start-up of the year award by Entrepreneur Awards, Delhi (2019),W-Power Award by Forbes India (2021), BW Disrupt 40 Under 40 Award by Businessworld (2021), Fortune's 40 Under 40 (2021), World Economic Forum's Young Global Leadership list (2022).



Apart from being an amazing entreprenuer, vineetha is also a sports enthusiast and she bagged a few medals during her college days at IIT-M
