




### **Feedback Report - 2018-2019**

1. 34% of the Students felt that the basis for choosing this college for a graduate programme is for ranking/impression. 33% of the students choose the college for courses offered, 21% for teaching standards, 17.8% for infrastructure, and 14.4% for NAAC grade.
2. 84.5% of the students said that the literacy/ cultural/sports activities helped them in realising their full potential.
3. 54.2% of the students said that the campus experience met their expectations to a large extent, whereas 45.8% of the students felt that it helped them to some extent.
4. 86.4% of the students felt that the mentoring system is helping them to a large extent.
5. 51.7% of the students said that the teachers prepared for the class thoroughly. 45.3% of the students felt that the teacher's preparation for the class was satisfactory.
6. 39.1% of the students felt that the institute often takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange and field visit. Whereas, 33.3% of the students said that the College regularly takes active interest in field trips, internships etc.
7. 79.3% of the students agrees that, the college provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow
8. 46.8% of the students said that the teachers will always illustrate the concepts through examples and applications. 42.3% of the students felt that the teachers regularly teach with examples and applications.
9. 45.7% of the students strongly agree that the teachers identify the strengths and encourage by providing the right level of challenges.
10. 55% of the students agree that the institution makes an effort to engage students in the reviewing and monitoring the teaching learning process.
11. 37.3% of the students felt that the teachers use Student centric methods to a great extent, whereas 44.5% of the students said that they use moderately.
12. Above 35% of the students felt that the teacher encourages participating in extracurricular activities and 28.4% said that every time teachers identify their weaknesses and help to overcome them.
13. Majority(24..5%) of the students felt that the infrastructure like Lab facilities, Library, NRC, ICT centre and Health centre is excellent.. Few Students felt it had to be improved.
