Student Satisfaction Survey (Exit Feedback) Analysis

2023-2024 (R21)

- 1. **Syllabus Covered:** 78.3% students opined of the syllabus covered for a range of 85% to 100%, 16.4% covered for a range of 70% to 84% and 3.9% for a range of 55% to 69%.
- 2. **Teachers Preparation:** 94% students rated that teachers thoroughly prepare for the classes and 6% rated as satisfactorily.
- 3. **Teachers Communication:** 90% students say that Teachers communication is always effective, 9% as sometimes effective and 1 % as just satisfactorily.
- 4. **Teachers approach in teaching:** 79% students rated as Excellent, 9% as very good, and 2% can be improved
- 5. Internal evaluation process by the teachers: 60% students rated as Always Fair, 32% as Usually Fair, 8% as Sometimes Unfair.
- 6. **Discussion about student performance by teachers:** 58% students rated as Every time, 31% as Usually, 11% as Occasionally/Sometimes
- 7. Institution promotes internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students:51 % students rated as regularly promotes,31 % as Often ,18% as sometimes
- 8. **Teaching and mentoring Process:** 74% students rated that institution teaching and mentoring process facilitates in cognitive, social and emotional growth as significantly, and Very Well, 21% as moderately and 5% as marginally.
- 9. **Opportunities to learn and grow**: 81 % students rated as strongly agree that Institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow and as agree, 15% as neutral and 4% as Disagree.
- 10. **Mentorship:** 59% students rated that mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to students every time, 33% as usually and 6% as Occasionally/Sometimes and 2% as Rarely
- 11. **Illustration through concepts**: 48% students rated that teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications every time, 48% rates as usually and 4% as Occasionally/Sometimes.
- 12. **Encouragement:** 48% students rated that teachers identify their students and encourage them with providing right level of challenges as fully, 39% as reasonably, and 13% as partially.

- 13. **Teachers are able to identify Student weaknesses**: 45% students rated as Every time that teachers are able to identify student weaknesses and help them to overcome, 35% as usually, 20% as Occasionally/Sometimes and 19.8% rarely.
- 14. **Institution students monitoring:** 83 % students rated as Strongly Agree that institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and Continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process as Agree, 17% as Neutral.
- 15. Centric Methods: 88 % students rated as to a great extent that institute/teachers

 Use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences and as moderate and 12% as somewhat
- 16. Extracurricular activities: 43.9% students rated as strongly agree that teachers encourage students to participate extracurricular activities, 38.5% as Agree and 15.6% as Neutral
- 17. Soft/Life/Employability: 52 % students rated as to a great extent that efforts are made by the institution / teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work, 40. % as moderate and 8% as somewhat.
- 18. **ICT tools**: 75% students rated as above 90% teacher's uses ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching, teachers uses Tools in range of 25% as below 60%.
- 19. Overall Teaching Learning Process: 80 % students rated as Strongly agree for overall quality of teaching learning Process is very good in the institute, 17% as Agree and 3% as Neutral

- 2. Industry talks through placement cell are organized to fill the gap between company and students.
