

Curriculum Organization





ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSIONS

- Two-year Intermediate Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana/Andhra Pradesh
- Examination of any other University / Board recognized as equivalent by the Intermediate Board.
- CBSE & ICSE students have to pass English and four other subjects i.e. a total of five subjects
- Candidates from other boards except Intermediate Board of Telangana, CBSE & ICSE Boards are required to submit Equivalency Certificate from the Board of Intermediate Education.
- The Admission of such candidates will be finalized only after the submission of Eligibility Certificate.

- College is a Christian minority institution and preference is given to christian students.


