6. Refreshments from the cafeteria are required to be consumed there. Littering is not permitted. The college premises and buildings should be kept clean.



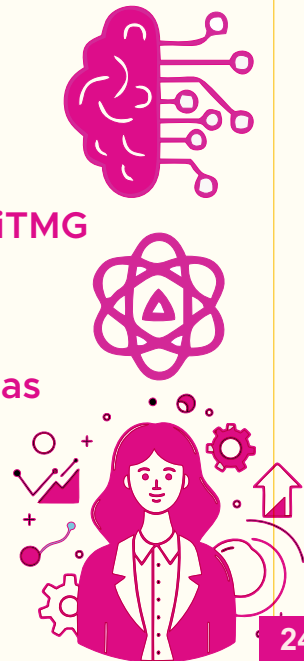

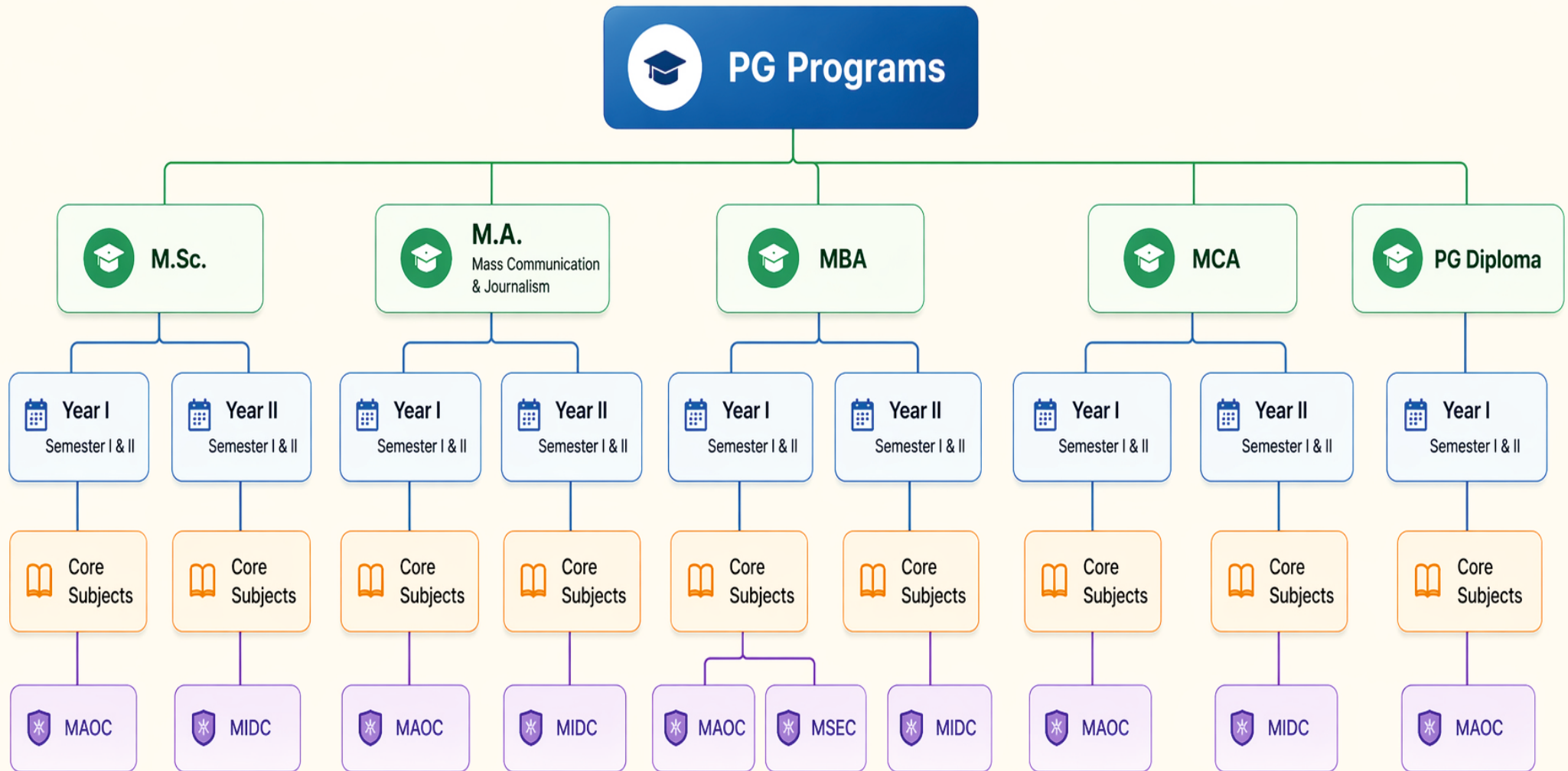
